Introduction

Most trainees after completing their core curriculum will after 4 years of general urology want to develop a special interest. These include oncology, andrology, female urology, reconstruction and neuro-urology or renal transplantation. Some trainees however will want to maintain a more general interest. Such trainees will usually want to develop special expertise in lower urinary tract dysfunction. They will however be competent in core urological procedures of nephrectomy and colposuspension.

Their training will be an extension of the core curriculum for a further 12 months (a total of five clinical years). They may have undertaken a flexible “out of programme” experience in research or some other area or discipline.

The operative programme is similar to that of core urology, but will aim at consolidating their experience.
